

Achieving Treatment for All: Hemophilia and Bleeding Disorders Educational Series Backgrounder

SERIES OVERVIEW: The video podcast series is designed to spur global dialogue around the need for broad-based access to care and treatment for people with hemophilia and other inherited bleeding disorders. It aims to raise awareness of the impact of these disorders on the global community, as well as call attention to disparities in care around the world.

<p>TOGETHER, WE CARE: A COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH TO BLEEDING DISORDERS</p>	<p>Explains the importance of comprehensive care in improving the lives of people with hemophilia and describes the comprehensive care team members and their specific roles in hemophilia care.</p>

IMPACT OF HEMOPHILIA AND BLEEDING DISORDERS: Hemophilia is a rare genetic bleeding disorder that primarily affects males. People with hemophilia do not have enough clotting factor, a protein in blood that controls bleeding. Hemophilia and other inherited bleeding disorders impact hundreds of thousands of people of all ethnicities, education levels and incomes, their families and their communities.
